


Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. is the first international fraternal organization founded on the campus of a historically black college.

On the evening of November 17, 1911, Omega Psi Phi was founded inside the Science Building (later renamed Thirkield Hall) at Howard University located in Washington, D.C. The founders were three undergraduates — <u>Edgar Amos Love</u>, Oscar James Cooper and Frank <u>Coleman</u>. Joining them was their faculty adviser, <u>Ernest Everett Just</u>.

From the initials of the Greek phrase meaning, "friendship is essential to the soul", the name Omega Psi Phi was derived. That phrase was selected as the motto and Manhood, Scholarship, Perseverance and Uplift were adopted as Cardinal Principles.

Since its founding in 1911, Omega Psi Phi's stated purpose has been to attract and build a strong and effective force of men dedicated to its Cardinal Principles of Manhood, Scholarship, Perseverance and Uplift. The Centennial Celebration in 2011 recognized the impact of the Fraternity in communities world-wide over the previous 100 years and reiterated Omega Psi Phi's commitment to providing unparalleled community service and scholarship.
