Our Mission

Scholarships-

Each year our Foundation awards several scholarships to local youth in consideration of their academic achievement, demonstrated leadership, volunteer activities, and participation in community service and support projects.



Essay Contests-

Our Foundation, in coordination with PLL, awards funding to winners of our local high school Essay Contest in November each year. Awards range from \$500.00 for 1st Place, \$300.00 for 2nd Place, and \$200.00 for 3rd Place.

Omega U — OMEGA U is career readiness mentoring program that focuses on character, leadership, scholarship, and community service by exposing students to various careers, lectures and tours, educational workshops, and seminars. The OMEGA U mentoring program provides after school and weekend activities to male students in our community.



Talent Hunt Program-

We make monetary awards to winners of an annual talent hunt program focused on identifying and providing exposure to talented local high school students in the performing arts arena. Students may compete in the following categories: 1) drama, 2) instrumental solo, 3) piano solo, 4) vocal solo, and 5) dance. Winners are selected by judges with experience in the medium they are judging.

Community Support-

In affiliation with PLL, the Foundation par-

ticipates in many community activities. We raise funds to support: an annual Diabetes drive; annual Relay for Life Cancer initiative; annual food drives; mentoring programs; and health related initiatives, including annual blood drives and local health fairs.
